On 17 South, by the "Hog House", the decking replacement was completed, but additional hands could have been utilized, and Will noted our volunteer base seems to be shrinking rather than growing, even with increased membership numbers. Sign-up with Will for your or your family's little bit of heaven, to remove large loose stones, and trim back the trees for groomer clearance. Considerable

damage was done to the groomer last year (windshield wipers and mirrors) due to the branches leaning into the trail from weight of snow. The trail from Birkensee to Lake Alice is being re-routed due to property sales. Lake signs were again discussed using lumber rather than barrels. Tank Jonas has a crew. There is logging on Trail 15 until hunting season, then it moves to the J Trail.
